G.T.C. GRAPHIC ARTS COMPETITION

Here's your chance to show off that poster that you are particularly proud of. G.T.C.'s Community Theatre Division is sponsoring this year's graphic arts competition. All producing organizations are eligible to enter (college, university, secondary, community, etc.). If you would like to enter one of your recent posters, the rules are simple:

- 1. The poster must be from a production that took place after November 8, 1992. (posters previously submitted for G.T.C. competition are not eligible).
- 2. The poster should be sent rolled or flat (not folded).
- The poster must be received by G.T.C. no later that October 15, 1993.

The posters will be juried, and cash prizes will be given for First Place (\$50) and Second Place (\$25). Third place will receive Honorable Mention. All posters that are entered will be displayed during the convention in Macon, November 4-7. Winners will be announced at the Awards Banquet.

GEORGIA THEATRE CONFERENCE ANNUAL PLAYWRIGHTING COMPETITION

GUIDELINES FOR ENTRY

The following quidelines apply to those interested in entering the competition:

- 1. A play of any length may be submitted, so long as:
 - a. it has not been published,
- b. it has not been professionally performed or produced, and
 - c. it is completely original.
- 2. A one-hour staged reading (Readers' Theatre format) of the winning play will be presented on the Friday evening of the annual GTC convention. A simple reception will follow the performance.
 - a. The winning playwright makes any cuts needed to bring the play down to the required playing time length before bringing it to the convention for presentation.
 - b. The playwright may elect to direct, or ask a member of the playwrighting contest committee to direct, but players will be selected from among those present at the convention.
- 3. The winning playwright will receive:
 - a. Convention registration paid,
 - b. Hotel room paid,
 - c. Banquet ticket paid, and
 - d. a check for \$100.

Meals other than the banquet, and travel, will be at the playwright's expense.

PROMPT BOOK COMPETITION The Community Theatre Division is once again sponsoring a Prompt Book Competition. Entries should be sent to jerry mittelhauser at Macon Little Theatre (4220 Forsyth Road, Macon, GA 31210) no later than October 15, 1993. Prompt books must be for actual productions which occur between November 8, 1992 and Novmber 7, 1993. Prompt books which have been previously entered in a GTC competition are not eligible. The prompt book should include cast list w/phone numbers; crew list w/phone numbers; rehearsal schedule; production meeting reports; blocking/choreography notes; preset checklists for props, scenery and on-stage costume changes; dimmer assignments for lights; lighting and sound cues for running the show, orchestra cues for running the show, scenery shift assignments, and a program for the production. The best prompt book will receive a \$50 award.
